We have had a lovely few days during this short week with lots of hard work, learning and fun, and all much easier because of the lovely sunny and dry weather! Yesterday, we all took part in assemblies about VE Day -80 Year anniversary. I learnt so

much about all of your families and all the family members who were involved in the war with lots of different countries. The children were so engaged and we all observed a 2 minute silence to show our respect for those who lost their lives, and of course to share the celebration that took place 80 years ago at the end of the war in Europe.

I always reassure the children, by saying that we expect them to do their best, and as long as they have tried hard and know they have done their very best, then we will be proud of them no matter what the result. Please reinforce this with your child at home.
