Please do not send your child to school if they have had any vomiting, diarrhoea and / or a high temperature in the past 24 hours. This will hopefully reduce the chance of transmission from your child to others and reduce the risk of your child becoming re-infected. It will hopefully also reduce the exposure of vulnerable groups of people such as infants and pregnant women to what can be a serious illness.
