The sun stayed out for most of the day and we had a steady flow of children and parents enjoying all the activities, food and games on offer. A special thanks to Alison Quinn who managed to coordinate everyone and make it a great day out! The total raised was in excess of £6000 –the most we have raised at one fair, so thank you everyone!

Well done to all of Year 6!

The children had a great time and were part of a Guinness World Record, that they were all very excited to tell me when they returned! Thank you Celeste for organising and to Judyann and Chris for helping out on the day too!

Also, this week, the Boy's Football Team took part in the Hackney Champions League and I am so thrilled to tell you that we won the cup! A brilliant turn around from our past couple of matches. A huge thank you to Dwayne and Sharon who have coached and supported the team all year! There will be a special treat for the team next week!

Today is the last race of the Hackney Cycling League. With Millfields 37 points ahead for the season going in to the race, I am hoping that we are well on course to win the league. Look out for the news next week!


