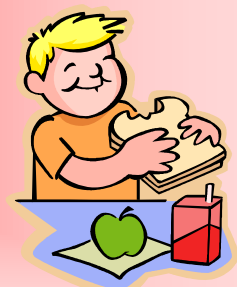
As the weather is now getting colder and icier it is important to ensure your child is appropriately dressed for any eventuality. We feel it is important for the children to have to opportunity to get some fresh air and exercise outside everyday so endeavour to let the children out as much as possible, barring particularly inclement weather. Please ensure your child is wearing uniform and comes to school with a warm coat and wearing appropriate closed toe footwear. In addition, we recommend the children should also bring with them a hat, gloves / mittens and a scarf. All staff encourage the children to dress warmly when going outside and working together we can help to keep your child healthy and warm. We also have a lot of children on trips next week so it is particularly important that they are dressed warmly. Children going to Ashwell school will need very warm clothing on their day of travel. The weather in that area of the country has dipped to -9 overnight and it doesn't get much warmer during the day, with these temperatures expected to continue into next week.



Dinners

Please remember that all dinner money should be paid in advance of a child having a dinner. Some accounts are currently in arrears. Please ensure you pay all monies owed as soon as possible. We will be contacting some parents individually to discuss their account, accounts significantly in arrears may find they can no longer receive a school meal.

If you are in receipt of some types of benefits you may be entitled to Free School meals. Pick up further information and the application form from Hackney Learning trust as soon as possible to apply. We will shortly be able to accept online and card payments we will let you know as soon as this system becomes active.
