What are they?

Expressed in a collection of creative inspiration cards designed by children and W+K people.

What is a creative inspiration card?


A two-sided card that captures an individual's creative moment and brought to life as a personal description and picture.

The cards will be shared between children and W+K people in a creative and collaborative Sharing and Exploration workshop, to inspire each other creatively.

The Creative Spark cards and evidence of the process will be displayed in an exhibition to showcase the journey and the end result

Learning Outcomes

- Enhanced Creative thinking
- Team work skills nurtured
- Confidence and Self Esteem raised
- learning from each other whilst engaging in a range of creatively broad activities that develop learning and awareness on many levels
- Validation of Creative ideas and thinking
- Speaking and listening skills enhanced
- Thinking, planning and executing skills developed
- Monitoring & evaluating skills enhanced



How does it work?

- 4 schools in East London will pilot Forever Curious 'Spark' in Education
- A lead teacher and 20 pupil premium students from years 3-5 will be selected by SLT
- This group of children and the teacher will work with a member of the WK team and our education consultant in a two hour workshop, where 'personal sparks' will be creatively explored
- 5 of the most interesting 'spark' moments will be selected by the group and ideas around how to articulate and re-create these moments in a creative way will be explored and developed. By the end of the workshop the five spark moments will have been developed into a creative activity/experience that can be shared with adults in the 'sharing and exploration workshop'
- WK staff will be doing to same. Identifying and working out how to share their 'Spark' moments with the children, in fun and meaningful ways
- A 3 hour sharing and exploration workshop will be run at a local venue for each school with the 20 children and staff involved, plus the 20 WK staff members, who as a group will collectively explore the spark activities, discuss and evaluate
- The Creative Spark cards will form part of a vibrant exhibition to showcase the project process & outcome and the launch can be visited by parents/carers, school staff and friends of WK
- A display can also be created by WK in each school taking part, to share the work with the wider school community and visitors

The Workshops



Introduction Workshop: School premises

20 children, 1 lead teacher, 1 WK education specialist, 5 WK Spark Leaders 2 hours (15 minutes with lead teacher)

- Introduction and welcome by W+K
- Introduction from school: A bit about you
- Warm up and ice breaker games
- Team exploration. What is creativity?
- WK share some of their creative spark moments
- Pair exploration: What is your Creative Spark? How could you re-create your Creative Spark for someone else to experience?
- Sharing ideas. Facilitated sensitively to support and nurture the children's belief in themselves and their ideas
- Discussion and evaluating & choosing final 5 spark moments
- Developing these into activities that can be shared


