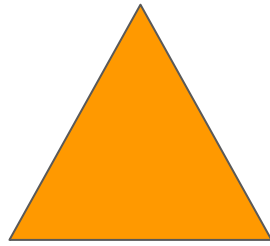

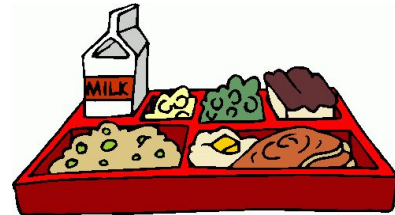
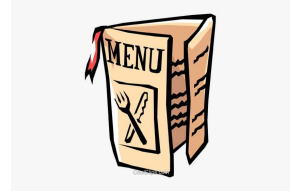
# Our School



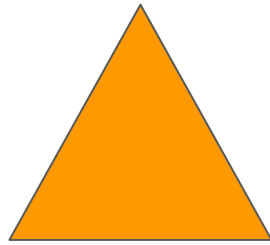
We plan to ensure there is more variety in the school dinners everyday so that there is always something for everyone to enjoy. We want bigger portions to reflect the age of the children too.

- Having more themed food days

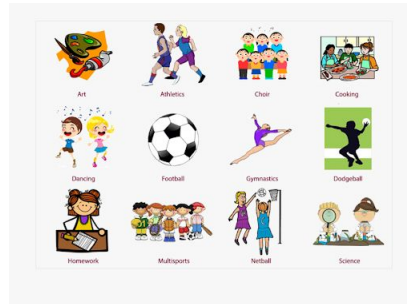


# Our Community



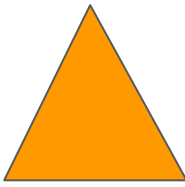
We know children have been affected by lockdowns and lack of socialisation and extra-curricular activities. That's why we plan to implement more after school clubs in our school and local community.
