#### The Scottish National Party



## News Today Focus Stolen Picasso Painting Found In Athens Nine Years After the Heist

On Monday 21st June 2021, the 'Women's Head' in Pablo Picasso's original Cubist style (1939) was found and recovered safely in Athens along with a Mill by Piet Mondrian (1905), nine years after the heist in Athens National Gallery.

The thieves burgled Athens National Gallery in 2012 in the early hours of the morning, distracting the galleries security guards by activating the security alarm several times.

Keeping the guards preoccupied, they were able to slink from the building and complete their elaborate plan. However, they dropped a third painting by Mondrian on their escape.



On Monday, a Greek police office reported that they had reclaimed the artwork that was given to the gallery by Picasso himself in 1949. The piece was give in remembrance of the countries resistance to the Nazi Germany, in a chasm by the border of Athens.

Officials are to have a meeting on the topic later today.






