



# Politics in focus: Divorce in Westminster!

Sajid Javid, the former Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, recently resigned from parliament yesterday. This was followed, in the same press conference, by Rishi Sunak. Read on to find out more.

During yesterday's press conference two of the most important people in British politics quit their jobs right in front of our prime minister, Alexander Boris de Pfeffel Johnson.

Both Javid and Sunak stepped down within minutes of each other and the pair of them said that they lack confidence in his leadership. Quoted by Rishi Sunak: "For me to step down as Chancellor while the world is suffering from economic consequences of the pandemic, the war in Ukraine and other serious challenges is a decision that I have not taken lightly. However, the public rightly expects government to be conducted properly, competently and seriously. I recognise this may be my last ministerial job but I believe these standards are worth fighting for and that is why I am resigning"

Boris Johnson also had to issue a grovelling apology for employing a certain person who had broken the law which many feel pushed Rishi Sunak and Sajid Javid to resign their jobs.


# The Latest Polls!
